KOOLTHERM IS CHOSEN FOR LOWRY LANDMARK MILLENNIUM PROJECT

Kooltherm phenolic duct insulation products from Kingspan Industrial Insulation Limited are playing a major role in The Lowry, the £65 million National Landmark Millennium Project for the Arts currently taking shape at Salford Quays near Manchester.

Righton Insulation Services Limited, working in close liaison with M & E Contractor Haden Young, is presently installing Kooltherm phenolic ducting insulation throughout the five storey complex which will have a facade wider than that of the Royal Albert Hall.

A total of 5,000 square metres of 25 mm thick Kooltherm duct insulation board comprising a core of low-K closed-cell phenolic foam and a Class '0' glass fibre reinforced aluminium foil was specified for the building's ventilation ducts.

The exciting venue for the arts will be a jewel in the crown of Britain's millennium celebration, consisting of three galleries, a 1,730-seat main auditorium, a 450-seat studio theatre, banqueting, conference and general hospitality facilities.

The project, due to be completed in April 2000, will also house a permanent exhibition of the life and work of the legendary Salford-born artist LS Lowry.
