The Cotman Centre, named after Norfolk artist John Sell Cotman was formed by the merger of the pathology departments at the Norfolk and Norwich and James Paget Hospitals to create the biggest single cervical screening service in the country.

Based in the Norwich Research Park, the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital (NNUH) were lucky to secure a former Institute of Food Research Lab complex for the conversion to the cellular pathology labs.

A total of 1,800 square metres of the Kingspan KoolDuct System was installed by Fabricators Environair Systems of Norfolk.
